 - Co-curricular activities such as clubs and class related academic activities and extracurricular activities such as sports.
 - Community (volunteer) service. Time, place and duration of activities should be included.
 - Work experience paid or unpaid. Include approximate number of hours.
4. Three (3) letters of recommendation – a minimum of two (2) from high school classroom instructors or administrators, and one (1) from outside of the education field. No letters of recommendation may come from relatives. (**Important:** letters must address the applicant's potential for success in the field of education.)
5. High school transcripts and, if applicable, college transcripts. (**Official** high school transcript through semester one of grade twelve plus an **official** college transcript. **Official Transcripts** must have an official stamp and signature from the school.)
6. Place all of the above items in a file folder with your name and school on the file folder tab and mail all in a large manila envelope to the WSSRA District Representative for your area. **Important:** the file folder is how the readers keep track of your information.
7. Mail (by first class mail) all of the above items, must be postmarked by **March 1, 2020**. Failure to address any of the above will result in disqualification of the application.
